## Re: 2025 Updates from Todd Creek Village Metropolitan District

Greetings TCVMD Customers,

We, your water service provider, write to you with a few TCVMD updates for the 2025 calendar year. First and foremost, our primary focus is to provide clean, safe drinking water and dependable customer service.

As an update to our customer service program, we are moving to electronic correspondence for all non-billing communications. Paper billing invoices will still be available. All homeowners are encouraged to sign up by filling out the notifications form on our website. Homeowner/occupant contact information is vital should an area emergency occur, and you can also opt-in to receive "Water Tips".

On November 14, 2024, the TCVMD Board of Directors approved a new Rates & Fees Schedule. This schedule is effective January 1, 2025, and can be found in its entirety on our website under "Your Water" > "Rates & Fees". This letter is a summary as it relates to your monthly bills. Please note that we bill on the final day of each month, due on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the following month. Therefore, the bill due January 15<sup>th</sup> is your bill from December 31, 2024, and has been billed according to the 2024 Rates & Fees Schedule.

Your 2025 water usage rates will remain the same as 2024. This is the cost of water usage billed per 1,000 gallons. Additionally, the Reserve Fee remains in place and is also unchanged from 2024. As a reminder, the Reserve Fee is a fee every customer is charged to fund large infrastructure repairs and updates to the system.

The Fixed Monthly Fee will rise slightly, approximately 3%, to continue to cover the costs of maintaining the system infrastructure and delivering water to your home. 2025 Fixed Monthly Fees are as follows:

The 2025 Conservation Fees will be calculated following the table below. The Conservation Fees help cover the overage cost of treating and distributing water to our customers when individual water usage is higher than the planned and allocated amount. These fees are also approximately a 3% increase from 2024.
