Delivering Quality Water Is Our Number One Goal

We have received questions recently about changes in the taste of our water, overall water quality, and what we are doing here at the Todd Creek Village Metro District to ensure that your drinking water is safe to consume. We can assure you that we are providing you with water that meets or exceeds EPA regulations for safe consumable water. Additionally, we are continually exploring ways of upgrading our system to ensure that we continue to bring you the best tasting quality water possible.



The sources of drinking water (both tap water and bottled water) include rivers, lakes, streams, ponds, reservoirs, springs, and wells. As water travels over the surface of the land or through the ground, it dissolves naturally occurring minerals and, in some cases, radioactive material, and can pick up substances resulting from the presence of animals or from human activity. Even after filtration and treatment to bring it to a safe and potable (drinkable) level, it may reasonably be expected to contain at least trace amounts of some contaminants.

The presence of these trace amounts of contaminants does not necessarily indicate that the water poses a health risk. That said, some people, especially those with compromised immune systems such as individuals undergoing chemotherapy, persons who have undergone organ transplants, people with HIV-AIDS or other immune system disorders, some elderly, and infants can be particularly at risk of infections. These individuals may be more vulnerable to contaminants in drinking water than the general population, and should seek advice about drinking water from their health care providers.
