Water Quality: We've Got You Covered in These Uncertain Times

As a nation and a community, we are facing uncertainty and some challenging times ahead that none of us would have imagined possible even a few months ago. It's certainly a time when we all have a heightened sensitivity surrounding health and safety for ourselves and our loved ones. We want you to know that delivering safe, quality drinking water to the Todd Creek Village neighborhoods is our number one goal and we are continuing to do everything we can and there is no reason for any concern.

Thankfully, beyond taking measures to protect the health and safety of our employees, our operations and water are not vulnerable to the COVID-19 virus pandemic. To protect our employees, we have been, and continue to follow all recommended guidelines for elevated hygiene and social distancing. The water itself, both at the source and during operations, is not directly impacted, and in fact, the regular treatment process includes a final step of chlorination that provides a naturally disinfecting barrier to any remaining bacteria after treatment and prior to distribution through the system. We are maintaining normal chlorine levels, but as always, due to varying flows of water and proximity to the treatment zone, the chlorine is sometimes more detectable to those with an acute sense of smell.

As a reminder, we source water from alluvial wells near the South Platte River. Our water rights allow us to utilize water out of the South Platte River (a renewable water source), purify it and distribute it through our system. We have several water storage reservoirs that allow us to pull water from the South Platte River whenever we need it. We are required by law to provide a water quality report, also known as a Consumer Confidence Report (CCR), by July 1st of each year. This report lists the regulated contaminants, if any, for that year's sampling requirements.

The results, along with the Safe Drinking Water Maximum allowable level, are always on the CCR. All of the water quality tests during the year's sample period will be reported on the CCR, which includes results from the previous year. Thus, the current CCR will be dated from the previous year. You can be assured that TCVMMD continues to meet and/or exceed all State and Federal water quality standards as set forth by the 1996 Safe Drinking Water Act and any other subsequent revisions.
