Fall and Winter Watering with Your Non-potable System

Colder weather is just around the corner bringing those frosty Colorado nights and varying levels of snow. That means it is time to winterize your sprinkler system and exterior water connection for the season. As a reminder, our system remains pressurized year round so we can flush the system throughout the winter to mitigate naturally occurring build-up.

As we've noted before, our friends at the Adams County CSU Extension Office are the experts on all things agriculture and they have some great information and general tips for you to help you care for your landscaping this time of year:

- ◆ Water trees, shrubs, lawns, and perennials during prolonged dry fall and winter periods to prevent root damage that affects the health of the entire plant, but only when air and soil temperatures are above 40 degrees F with no snow cover.
- ◆ Established large trees have a root spread equal to, or greater than, the height of the tree. Apply water to the most critical part of the root zone within the drip line
